These information sessions will provide attendees with an opportunity to find out more about the proposed wind farm, as well as ask questions directly of RE Future representatives.

Session themes

The upcoming information sessions will be attended by representatives of the ecological and acoustic consulting firms that performed assessments of the proposed wind farm. In particular, a representative of Ecology and Heritage Partners, who completed the Ecological Assessment and standalone Brolga Assessment, will be in attendance at the sessions held on Thursday 10 October, while a representative of Marshall Day, who completed the predictive noise assessment, will be in attendance at the sessions held on Thursday 17 October. Accordingly, should you wish to find out more information about one of these topics in particular, please register for one of the sessions at which the relevant subject matter expert will be in attendance.

Session format: Our plan is to start with a short presentation about the wind farm followed by a question-and-answer session afterwards. However, we will be flexible if those present wish to discuss a particular topic at length or wish to skip straight to questions and answers. Please note that the maximum group size will be ten participants per timeslot—this small group setting will allow for a more detailed discussion and personalised attention to your questions.
